

ORDINANCE NO. 239-1

AN ORDINANCE ELECTING TO RECEIVE STATE
REVENUE SHARING FUNDS.

THE CITY OF DRAIN ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: The State of Oregon through legislation enacted during the 1977 session has set aside an additional 14% of state liquor revenues to be available for requesting cities; and the City of Drain hereby requests its full allocation under the program.


Section 2: The applicable law requires the City of Drain to hold public hearings before the budget committee and the City Council and these hearings will be held prior to July 31, 1977.

Section 3: Uses of the funds will be determined by information presented at the hearings and laws relating to Supplemental Budgets will be followed before expenditure of the funds. All expenditures will be made in accordance with state revenue sharing rules and regulations and local budget law.

Section 4: WHEREAS, it is in the public interest of the people of the City of Drain that this take place at the earliest possible moment, and emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor
