

ORDINANCE NO. 251

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE TAX LEVY OUTSIDE THE LIMITATIONS IMPOSED BY ARTICLE XI., SECTION II OF THE OREGON CONSTITUTION, FOR THE PURPOSE OF OPERATING THE CITY OF DRAIN, ADOPTING THE OPERATING BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1978-79, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREFORE, the budget of the City of Drain for the fiscal year July 1, 1978 through June 30, 1979 calls for a tax levy of \$77,971.00 against all taxable property within the City of Drain for the purpose of deriving funds necessary to carry on the functions of the City Government; and

WHEREAS, the tax levy within the limitations of Article XI., Section II of the Oregon Constitution is not sufficient for raising the funds necessary to carry on the regular functions of the city and to meet the expenses; and

WHEREAS, there was submitted to the electors of the City of Drain at a special election on June 6, 1978 for their approval or rejection the following proposition:

"Shall the City of Drain, Douglas County, Oregon increase the tax levy for the fiscal year 1978-79 over the amount limited by Section II, Article XI of the Constitution of Oregon by the sum not to exceed \$20,096.00?"

and,

WHEREAS, at said regular election there were cast 64 ballots in favor of said proposition and 54 ballots against said proposition and that said proposition carried and said election was in all respects regular and according to law;

NOW THEREFORE, the City of Drain ordains as follows:


Section 1. That the City of Drain, Douglas County, Oregon, hereby increases the tax levy against all taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Drain outside the limitations imposed by Article XI., Section II of the

Oregon Constitution by the sum of \$20,096.00, commencing the fiscal year July 1, 1978, for the purpose of carrying on regular functions of the City and to meet expenses.

Section 2. BE IT RESOLVED, that the Budget Officer file with the County Assessor, County Clerk and the State of Oregon Department of Revenue a true copy of the operating budget as adopted.


Section 3. IT IS HEREBY found and determined that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of Drain, and owing thereto an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
