An Ordinance initiating the vacation of the following described right-of-way, to-wit:

That portion of "C" Street lying between Blocks 20 and 21 of the Plat of Drain as platted and recorded in Volume 1, Page 56 of the Douglas County, Oregon Plat Records.

THE CITY OF DRAIN ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Drain herein initiates the vacation proceedings on its own authority without petition or consent of the property owners, except as provided by statute, of the above-described right-of-way.

Section 2. A hearing shall be held on the proposal to vacate the right-of-way as herein provided, and the hearing shall be held on the 10th day of April, 1979, at 8:00 PM Pacific Standard Time on said date, at which time all persons will be heard upon objections or suggestions with regard to the vacation and at said time the Council will provide for the vacation of the right-of-way or deny such vacation, and in case the vacation is made, will provide and make provision for any damages sustained by local assessment.

Section 3. The City Recorder is hereby directed to immediately publish once each week for four consecutive weeks in a newspaper published in Drain, Douglas County, Oregon,

notice of the proposed vacation. The notice shall give a description of the area to be vacated as herein set out; state the date when this ordinance was passed, the name of any petitioners petitioning for the vacation, and the date when the petition, together with any objections or remonstrances which may be made in writing and filed with the Recorder of the City of Drain prior to the date of hearing, will be heard and considered.

Section 4. The City Recorder shall forthwith and within five days after the first publication of the notice post or cause to be posted, at or near each end of the proposed vacation a copy of the foregoing, which shall be headed "Notice of Right-of-Way Vacation", and which Notice shall be posted in at least two conspicuous places in or on the area proposed to be vacated.

The posting and the first day of publication of the Notice shall be not less than twenty-eight (28) days before the time set for hearing.
