ORDINANCE No. 296

AN ORDINANCE FIXING ELECTRICAL RATES
AND AMENDING ORIGINAL ORD. #264,
ORD. #280 AND ORD. #291.

THE CITY OF DRAIN ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

Schedule A-3, Residential Service, Section 7.4453
amended to read as follows:

7.4453 Monthly Rate

Basic Customer Charge: \$8.50 (No KWH's included
in basic charge)

Energy Charge: All KWH per month @ 3.95¢
per KWH

Section 2.

Schedule RSCR-3, Reduced Rates for Senior Citizens,
Section 7.4456 is amended to read as follows:

Yearly Income is less than:	Basic Charge (1410 KWH included)	Energy Charge (all over 1410 KWH)
Single \$5,600	\$17.00	3.95¢/KWH
Family \$7,000	\$17.00	3.95¢/KWH

Section 3.

Schedule B-3, General and Commercial Power Service, Section 7.4503 and Section 7.4504 is amended to read as follows:

7.4503 Monthly Rates

Basic Customer Charge

Single-phase service	(No KWH's included in basic charge)	\$10.00 per month
Three-phase service	(No KWH's included in basic charge)	\$14.00 per month

Demand Charge

KW of demand per month. \$4.00 per month

Energy Charge

First 10,000 KWH	3.95¢ per KWH
Next 30,000 KWH	3.75¢ per KWH
Next 60,000 KWH	3.56¢ per KWH
All over 100,000 KWH	3.16¢ per KWH

7.4504 Demand Charge

First 10 kilowatts of billing demand per month, no demand charge. Excess above 10 kilowatts of billing demand per month at \$4.00 per kilowatt.

Section 4.

Schedule SL-3, Street and Highway Lighting, Section 7.4553 is amended to read as follows:

7.4553 Rate

Basic Charge:	\$10.00 (No KWH's included in basic charge)
Plus	
Energy Charge:	All KWH per month @ 3.0¢ per KWH

Section 5.

Schedule YL-3, Security and Outdoor lighting, No change at this time.

Section 6.

Schedule I-3, Swimming Pool, is amended to read as follows:

7.4663	<u>Monthly Rate</u>	
	Basic Charge:	\$10.00 (No KWH's included in basic charge)
	Energy Charge:	All KWH per month 3.0¢ per KWH

This ordinance is to be effective June 20, 1982 for the July 1982 billing which is mailed out on or before August 1, 1982.

Section 7.

The provisions contained herein concern the public welfare and safety and, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall become effective as noted above upon its passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
