Third Street from the North side of "E" Street Northerly to the North west corner of lot

Fourth Street from the southwest corner of Lot seven (7) Block fifteen (15) Northerly to the North west corner of Lot eight (8) Block thirteen (13) be and the same, and each part thereof, hereby are declared vacated.
