

An Ordinance Amending Drain's Environmental Code (Ord. 290)
Section 6.010 to Define Abandoned Vehicles
Which are Nuisances and Declaring an Emergency

THE CITY OF DRAIN ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 6.010 of Drain's Public Improvement Code is hereby amended to add subsection (m) to read as follows:

- (m) Abandoned Vehicles. No owner or person in charge of property shall permit thereon the parking, storing, or leaving of any licesed or unlicensed motor vehicle of any kind which is in a rusted, wrecked, junked, or partially dismantled or inoperative or abandoned condition, whether attended or not:
1. For more that seventy-two (72) hours but less than thirty (30) days unless the vehicle is completely screened from public view.
 2. For more than thirty (30) days unless the vehicle is completely enclosed within a building.
 3. The prohibitions in this subsection do not apply if the vehicle is maintained by a business enterprise authorized to maintain such vehicles under the land use laws and regulations of the City.

Section 2. The provisions contained herein affect the public welfare and safety, and therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
