ORDINANCE NO. 369

AN ORDINANCE REINSTATING ORDINANCE NO. 217 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE CITY OF DRAIN ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

 $\underline{\text{Section One.}}$ Reaffirm that Ordinance No. 217 is still in effect since its date of passage, and that the repeal by the general repealing Ordinance No. 363 was unintentional.

<u>Section Two.</u> Ordinance No. 217 provides for the vacation of that portion of a street bounded on the West by the center line of Elk Creek and bounded on the East by the West boundary of 4th Street, City of Drain.

<u>Section Three.</u> The provisions contained herein, concern the public welfare and safety, and therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
