

ORDINANCE NO. 378

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING A CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF DRAIN, OREGON AND REVISING, AMENDING, RESTATING, CODIFYING AND COMPILING THE EXISTING GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF DRAIN DEALING WITH THE SUBJECTS CONTAINED IN SUCH CODE OF ORDINANCES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the present general and permanent ordinances of the political subdivision are inadequately arranged and classified and are insufficient in form and substance for the complete preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the municipality and for the proper conduct of its affairs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Drain desires to revise, amend, restate, codify and compile its existing ordinances and all new ordinances not heretofore adopted or published, and to incorporate such ordinances into one ordinance in book form; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide for the usual daily operation of the City of Drain and for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the people of Drain that this ordinance take effect immediately;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF DRAIN ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The general ordinances of the City of Drain as revised, amended, restated, codified and compiled in book form are hereby adopted as and shall constitute the "Code of Ordinances of the City of Drain, Oregon.

Section 2. Such Code of Ordinances as adopted in Section 1 shall consist of the following Titles:


A full and complete copy of the Code of Ordinances hereby adopted is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

Section 3. All prior ordinances pertaining to the subject treated in such Code of Ordinances, shall be deemed repealed from and after the effective date of this ordinance, except as they are included and reordained in whole or in part, in such Code; provided, such repeal shall not affect any offense committed or penalty incurred, or any right established prior to the effective date of this ordinance, nor shall such repeal affect the provisions of ordinances levying taxes, appropriating money, annexing or detaching territory, establishing franchises, or granting special rights to certain persons, authorizing public improvements, authorizing the issuance of bonds or borrowing of money, authorizing the purchase or sale of real or personal property, granting or accepting easements, plat or dedication of land to public use, vacating or setting the boundaries of streets or other public places; nor shall such repeal affect any other ordinance of a temporary or special nature or pertaining to subjects not contained in or covered by the Code.



- Section 4. If any provisions of the Code adopted hereby, or the application thereof to any person is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or application of the Code which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of the Code are severable.
- Section 5. Such Code shall be in full force and effect as provided in Section 6, and such Code shall be presumptive evidence in all courts and places of the ordinance and all provisions, section, properly signed, attested, recorded and approved and that any public hearings and notices thereof as required by law have been given.
- Section 6. This ordinance affects the public peace, health and safety of the City of Drain and, therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance and Code shall be in full force and effect from the date of its passage.
