THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF DRAIN ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
Section 1. That all persons who have no visible means of support or lawful occupation by which to earn a living; all persons who shall be found begging the means of support; all persons who shall habitually roam about the streets without any lawful business; all idle or dissolute persons who live in or about houses of ill fame; all persons who shall roam about the streets at night after twelve o'clock midnight without having any lawful business upon the streets at that time; shall be deemed vagrants, and all such persons found within the City of Drain shall be guilty of vagrancy.

Section 2. All persons within the City of Drain who have no visible means of living or lawful occupation by which to earn a living; all persons who shall be found within said City begging alms or the means of support; all persons who shall habitually roam about the streets of said City without lawful business or idle or dissolute persons who live in or about or loiter in or about houses of ill fame, or gambling houses; all common prostitutes; all persons having no occupation or business who shall be found wandering about the streets of said City after the hour of twelve $o^{\prime}$ clock midnight; and all persons within said City upon whom shall be found any instrument or thing used for the commission of robbery or burglary or for picking pockets or locks, and who can not give a good account of their possession of the time, shall be deemed and are hereby declared to be vagrants, and shall be guilty of vagrancy.

Section 3. All vagrants within the City of Drain who, upon conviction of being a vagrant, or of vagrancy, as defined in Section 1 or 2 of this ordinance, shall be punished by a fine of not more than Three Hundred Dollars ( $\$ 300.00$ ) or by imprisonment in the City Jail not to exceed ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment; and any person who shall, upon conviction, fail, neglect or refuse to pay any such fine, shall be imprisoned in the City Jail one day for each Two Dollars $\$ 2.00$ ) of said fine.
