

ORDINANCE NO. 82.

AN ORDINANCE TO PREVENT THE KEEPING OF HOUSES OF ILL FAME, BROTHEL, OR BAWDY HOUSES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF DRAIN, OREGON, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF DRAIN ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to open or set up or keep within the corporate limits of the City of Drain any house of ill fame, brothel or bawdy house for the purpose of prostitution, fornication or lewdness.

Section 2. Any person who shall open, set up or keep within the corporate limits of the City of Drain any house of ill fame, brothel or bawdy house or who shall knowingly aid or assist in setting or keeping any house of ill fame, brothel, or bawdy house, upon conviction thereof before the City Recorder shall be punished by imprisonment in the City Jail not less than five nor more than ten days or by a fine not less than Ten Dollars nor more than Fifty Dollars, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 3. In all cases of prosecution under this ordinance common fame shall be competent evidence in support of the complaint and every house or place used for the purpose of prostitution, fornication or lewdness shall be taken and deemed to be a bawdy house within the meaning of this ordinance and any person residing in any such house with a knowledge of its character shall conclusively presumed in any prosecution against such person or persons that he or she keeps such house.

Section 4. It shall be the duty of the City Marshal to institute prosecution for the violation of this ordinance whenever he shall have reasonable cause to believe that any person or persons have been guilty of the violation of the same.
