

ORDINANCE NO. 83.

AN ORDINANCE TO PREVENT GAMBLING WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF DRAIN, OREGON, PROVIDING A PENALTY AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF DRAIN ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Each and every person who shall, within the corporate limits of the City of Drain, Oregon, deal, play or carry on, open or cause to be opened or who shall conduct either as owner, proprietor or employe, whether for hire or not, any game of faro, monte, roulette, rougette, noir, lanqnet, rondo, vingtun, (or twenty-one), poker, draw poker, brag, bluff, thaw, or any banking or other game played with cards, dice or any other device, for money, checks, credits or any other representative of value, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before the City Recorder shall be punished by a fine of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00), nor more than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00), or by imprisonment in the City Jail not to exceed ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment, and upon his failure to pay any such fine, such person shall be imprisoned in the City Jail one day for each Two Dollars (\$2.00) of such fine.

Section 2. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.
