

ORDINANCE NO. 89

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DEPOSITING OF ASHES
AND REFUSE IN WOOLEN, PAPER OR OTHER INFLAMMABLE
RECEPTACLES OF ANY KIND..

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF DRAIN ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, firm or corporation to deposit, place or keep any ashes or refuse matter whatsoever taken from any stove, fireplace or furnace, in any wooden or paper box or barrel or any wooden, paper or other inflammable receptacle of any kind within the corporate limits of the City of Drain, Oregon.

Section 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof before the City Recorder, shall be punished by a fine of not more than Twenty-Five Dollars or by imprisonment in the City Jail not more than ten days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
